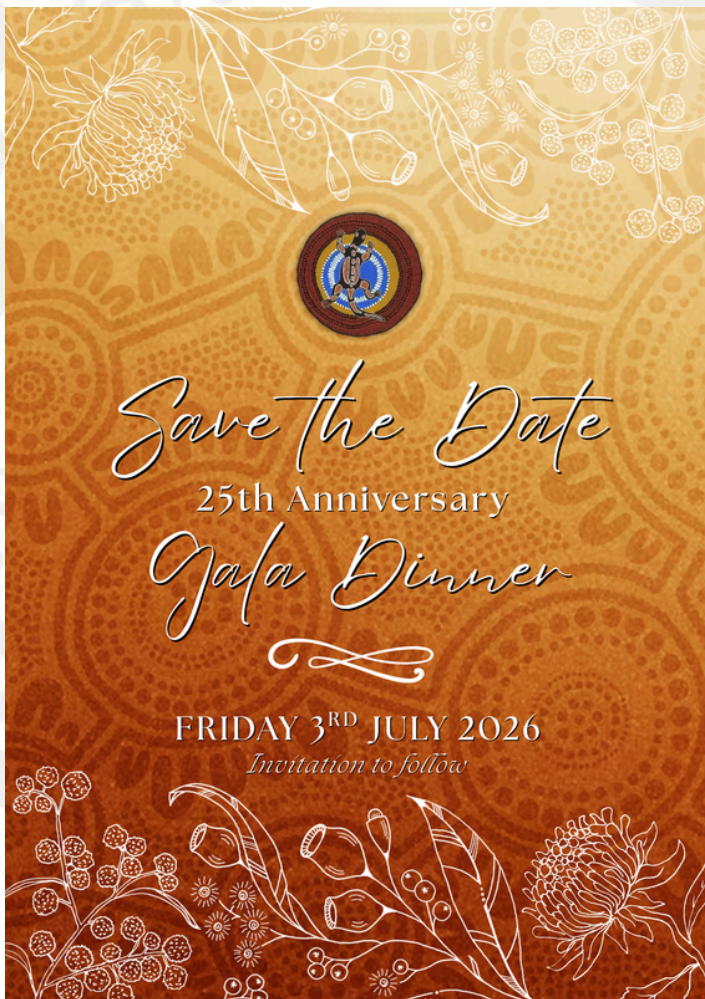


SAVE THE DATES
